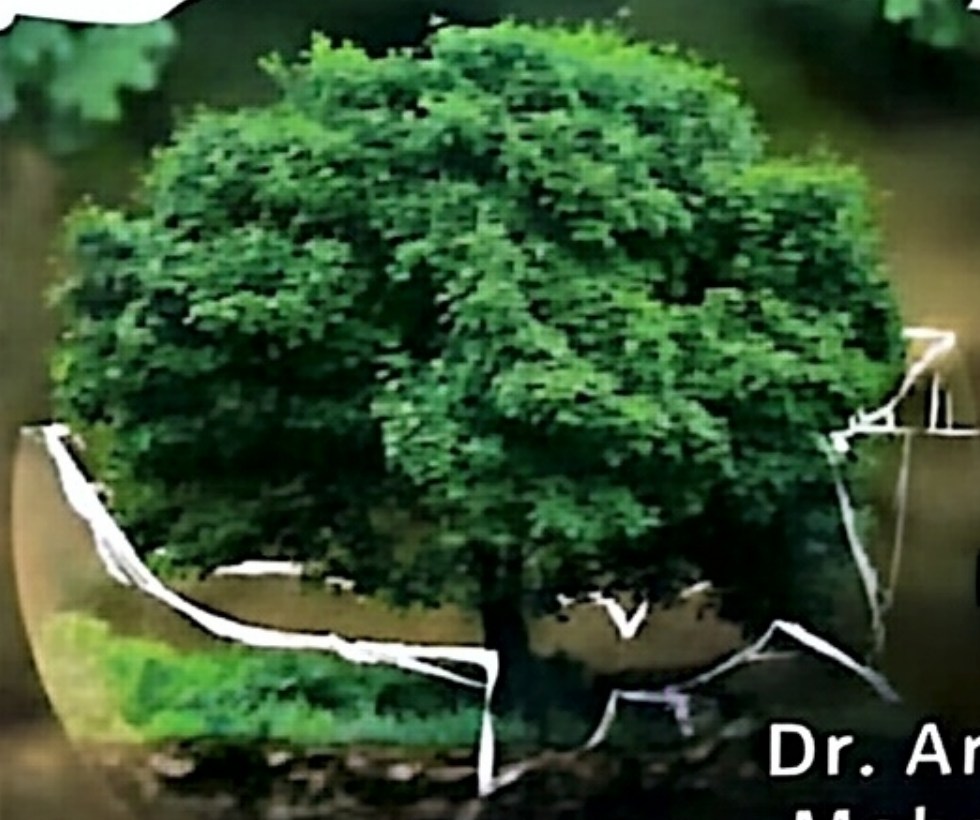

2. second ‘idea of limitations’ imposed by the state of technology and social organisation on the environment’s ability to meet the present and future needs.

These ideas are the moral imperatives in fulfilling the urgent development needs of the world’s poor living in developing countries and the threat to continued progress as a result of the
